

CONTROL OF PORTS OPERATING WITHOUT PERMIT AND CONTROL OF TEMPORARY PERMIT

(Circular of Director General of Sea Communication No. UK.11/24/18/DJPL-08, dated October 24, 2008)

1. That currently, there are still ports operating without permit, ports having permits but used not in accordance with provisions of legislations, and permits issued temporarily.
2. In order to follow-up directives of the Minister of Communications, and in the context of administration order and legal order, the related technical Directorate and Port Administrator (Adpel)/ Heads of Port Offices (Kakanpel)) in accordance with its primary duty and functions, are required to immediately execute the following matters:
 - a. To inventory / evaluate port permits within the work area of each Adpel / Kanpel.
 - b. To control ports operating without permit or port having a permit, but used not in accordance with its permit.
 - c. To check regulations on the delegation of authority on the control and the signing of temporary permits executed by Echelon-II Officials of Adpel / Kanpel; in the event it still occurs, to be reported immediately for revision.
 - d. Not to issue and sign location permit, operations permit, dredging permit and reclamation permit that are temporary in nature.
 - e. To report its results to the Director General of Sea Communication periodically every three (3) months.
3. Thus for your attention and to be executed.
