

DECREE FROM THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE

Number 737/Kpts/TD.630/11/1985

on

TRANSPORTATION OF CITRUS PLANTS AND/OR SEEDS
TO AVOID THE SPREAD OF CVPD

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE

- considering :
- a. that the Minister of Agriculture has with the decree/Kpts/Um/3/1982 issued the prohibition of transportation of citrus that is infected by the CVPD disease,
 - b. that several areas outside Java and Sumatra are already infected by the CVPD disease,
 - c. that areas/islands free from CVPD should be protected from the spread of said disease,
 - d. that based on the above it is necessary to re-arrange transportation procedures of citrus plants and/or seeds to avoid the spread of CVPD

D E C I D E S

determines : that the decree from the Minister of Agriculture on the transportation of citrus plants and/or seeds to avoid the CVPD disease,

Article 1

In this Decree and its annexes the following are meant :

- a. Transportation is transfer of plants and/or seeds from one place/area to another place/area carried by hand or transportation means.
- b. Endemic areas are areas/provinces where the greater part of the citrus plants have been continuously infected by the CVPD disease and causes losses to the farmers
- c. Non-endemic areas are areas/provinces where a small part of the citrus plants have been infected by the CVPD and sometimes cause losses to the farmers
- d. Non infected areas are areas where the citrus plants have not yet been infected by the CVPD

Article 2

The transportation of citrus plants and/or seeds should be accompanied by a label stating exemption of CVPD disease and legalized by the SCCS.

Article 3

The label stating exemption of CVPD should have a general form based on rules/guidelines issued by the Directorate General of Food Crops Production

Article 4

Transportation of citrus plants and seeds are prohibited when :

- a. there is no label as in point above
- b. transported from CVPD endemic areas to non-endemic and/or areas free from CVPD

c. transported from non-endemic to areas free from CVPD

Article 5

Determination of endemic, non-endemic areas and areas free from CVPD, as stated in the Annex of this Decree.

Article 6

Violation of Article 4 of this Decree is subject to sanction in line with valid law

Article 7

Execution and supervision of the conditions in this Decree are carried out by the Plant Quarantine, SCCS and Provincial Government.

Article 8

1. Supervision on the execution of conditions in point 4 .b and a. is carried out by the Plant Quarantine and Provincial Government
2. Supervision on inter-area transportation in endemic, non-endemic and/or areas free from CVPD is done by officials from SCCS and the Provincial Government. ,

Article 9

With the validity of this Decree, Ministerial Decree number 129/Kpts/Um/8/1982 is declared not valid anymore.

Article 10

Matters not yet treated or not yet sufficiently treated in this Decree will be discussed later.

Article 11

This Decree is valid as of the day of stipulation.
