

## **PENALTIES**

Offenders of the Game and Fish Laws approved in Khordad 1346 ( June 1967) will be prosecuted as follows:

Article 10 – Persons committing any one of the following offenses are liable to imprisonment from 11 days to one month or at fine of 1,000 to 5,000 Rials.

a) Hunting during unlawful seasons and hours.

b) Hunting and fishing, with unlawful means or methods.

c) Cutting, destruction, or desecration of trees or plants in Protected Regions.

d) Hunting and fishing, transporting or sale of all live game animals without a license.

e) Transporting, displaying, selling or exporting the carcasses of game animals or portions thereof without the permission of the Game and Fish Depart -

ment.

Article 11-Persons hunting or fishing without a license are liable to imprisonment from 11 days to two months or a fine of 1,000 to 10,000 Rials.

Article 12- Persons committing any one of the following offences are liable to imprisonment from one month to three months, or a fine of 5,000 to 20,000 Rials

a) Hunting or fishing in Imperial Reserves.

b) Hunting or fishing for protected species without a license.

c)Hunting without a Special License in Protected Regions or private reserves

d) Cutting or mutilating trees or plants in Wildlife Parks.

e) Constructing dams or diversions or structures in rivers or streams for catching fish.

f) Polluting rivers, lakes, ghanats,

marshes or bodies of water which causes the death or destructon of aquatic or terrestrial animals.

Article 13- Persons committing any one of the following offences are liable to imprisonment from three months to one year or a fine of 20,000 to 50,000 Rials:

a) Hunting, fishing or causing the destruction of animals through the use of explosives such as dynamite.

b) Hunting without a license for Goitered Gazelle, Jabeer Gazelle, Wild Ass or the Fallow Deer.

c) Hunting or fishing without a license for all animals imported from abroad and declared protected.

d) Hunting or fishing without a license in Wildlife Parks.

The Ministry of war, at the request of the Game and Fish Department, will revoke the Arms Licenses of any offenders of the above laws and regulations.
