

S.I. No. 182/2011 — Sea-Fisheries (Recording of Fish) (No. 2) (Revocation) Regulations 2011.

I, SIMON COVENEY, Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 12 of the Sea-Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Act 2006 (No. 8 of 2006) and the Sea-Fisheries, Foreshore and Dumping at Sea (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 707 of 2007) (as adapted by the Agriculture and Food (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2007 (S.I. No. 705 of 2007)), hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sea-Fisheries (Recording of Fish) (No. 2) (Revocation) Regulations 2011.

2. The Sea-Fisheries (Recording of Fish) (No. 2) Regulations 2011 are revoked.
