

ANIMAL DISEASES REGULATIONS (FEEDING OF ANIMALS), 2001

By virtue of the powers vested in me pursuant to Section 22 of the *Animal Diseases Ordinance [New Version]*, 1985¹, with the permission of the Economic Committee of the Knesset and according to Section 48(a) of *Basic Law: The Government*² and Section 2(b) of the *Penal Code*, 1977³, I hereby enact the following Regulations:

1. Definitions:

In these Regulations:

"Manure" - a substance containing avian or mammalian excretions;

"Milker" - a female goat or a ewe aged over one year, or a cow aged over two years, producing milk for human consumption;

"Mammals" - animals from the mammalia class;

"Poultry cadavers" - carcasses of poultry or any parts thereof, excluding those slaughtered according to the *Animal Diseases Regulations (Poultry Abattoirs)*, 1960⁴;

"A Plant" - premises where products for the feeding of animals are produced from cadavers of animals.

2. Prohibition on Feeding:

(a) A person shall not feed poultry intended for human consumption –

(1) with protein and meals produced from:

(a) mammals, excluding protein present in milk and milk products and in Dicalcium Phosphate;

(a) poultry and fish, unless the Plant in which they were produced was certified by the Director of the Veterinary Services of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development;

(a) poultry cadavers.

(2) with the manure of mammals.

(b) A person shall not feed mammals intended for human consumption -

(1) with protein and meals produced from animals, excluding protein present in milk and milk products and in Dicalcium Phosphate;

- (b) with the manure of mammals;
- (c) with the manure of poultry -
 - (a) milkers;
 - (a) other mammals, during the 15 days prior to their slaughter.

3. Cancellation:

The Animal Diseases Regulations (Feeding of Animals), 1996⁵ - are hereby cancelled.
