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By virtue of my authority under Sections 4, 12, 14 and 15 of the control on the Export of Livestock and animal Products Law – 1957 (hereinafter: the "Law") and Section 22a. of the Animal Diseases Ordinance [New Version] – 1985 (hereinafter: the "Ordinance"), and in consultation with advisory committees in accordance with Section 17 of the Law, with the approval of the Knesset Economy Committee, in accordance with Section 48(A) of the Basic Law – Government and Section 2(B) of the Penal Law – 1977, and in the matter of Regulation 9 with the approval of the Minister of Finance under Section 39B of the Foundations of the Budget Law – 5985, and with the approval of the Knesset Finance Committee under Section 1(B) of the Basic Law: - National Economy, I hereby enact the following regulations:

Definitions

1. In these Regulations:

Plant Owner: Including the manager of the plant, its operator or a partner therein;

The E.U. Requirements: Canceled;

Controller: As defined in Section 3 of the Law;

The Director: The Director of the Veterinary Services;

Plant: A place used for the production of animal products;

Approved Plant: A plant approved under Regulation Consignment – the quality of a product sent under one certificate;

Veterinary Inspector: A veterinarian authorized by the Director for the purposes of these Regulations in respect of a particular plant;

Terms of Export

2. ¹No person shall export animal products unless these have been produced in an Approved Plant in compliance with provisions of the Law, the Ordinance, and these regulations in

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the following activities: collection, sorting, conveyance, processing, pasteurization, disinfection, sterilization, preservation, packing and packaging, marking and storage thereof, the persons involved in the production, transportation and the vehicles in which they were transported.

Application for approval of a plant

3. An application for the approval of a plant shall be submitted to the Director, signed by the Plant Owner, according to [Form 1](#) of the Amendment. If the owner is a corporation it has also to enclose an accountant conformation of signatory rights.
4.
 - a. The Director shall grant a Plant the status of an Approved Plant if the following terms have been fulfilled:
 - i. the Plant has a valid license under the Business Licensing Law – 1968, and a Manufacturer's License under the Control of Commodities and Services Order (Food Trade, Manufacture and Storage) – 1960;
 - ii. the Requirements of the authorities in the destination country have been fulfilled;
 - iii. the appointment of a Veterinary Inspector under sub-regulation (B) is practicable.
 - b. If the Director has approved a Plant, a Veterinary Inspector shall be appointed for that Plant, and approval for the operation of the Plant shall be granted according to [Form 2](#) of the Amendment.
 - c. The certification will be effective for a period of a year from the day it was given.

Veterinary Inspector's Report

5. The Veterinary Inspector shall report to the Director, by the tenth of each month, specifying the number of Consignments which he has approved for the Controller's inspection during the previous month and the type of animal products inspected, indicating the date of production and countries of designation, the number of testing performed, their nature and the number of consignments refused for export. The report shall be presented in accordance with [Form 3](#) of the Amendment.

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Cancellation and Suspension of Approval

6. Should the Director note that the requirements which served as the basis of this approval have ceased to exist at an Approved Plant, he may suspend or cancel his approval. However this shall not be done before the Plant Owner has been given an opportunity to submit his claims in writing.

Inspection of Animal Products

7. Animal Products shall be submitted for inspection by the Controller, accompanied by a certified signed by the Veterinary Inspector, in such wording as the Director shall require, in which the Veterinary Inspector has certified that the product is fit for export to a particular destination, and complies with the provisions of Regulation 2.

Controller's Decision

8.
 - a. Should the Controller approve the Animal Product for export, a certificate conforming to the requirements of the country of destination or the Director's requirements shall be attached thereto. The certificate shall determine the export requirements in order to assure the quality of the product; a copy of the certificate shall be submitted to the Plant Owner.
 - b. Should the Controller refuse to approve an Animal Product for export, or cancel such an approval, by virtue of his authority under Section 5 of the Law, he shall notify the Plant Owner of his action, in writing, within twenty four hours of the product being submitted for his approval, and shall stipulate the grounds for his refusal or cancellation.
 - c. Should the Controller refuse to inspect an Animal Product, by virtue of his authority under Section 7 of the Law, he shall notify the Plant Owner, the owner of the Animal Product, and the Director, of his decision, in writing, within 7 days of the date of refusal, and shall stipulate the grounds for his decision.
 - d. The Controller shall notify the Plant Owner or the Owner of the Animal product, as the case may be, in writing, of their right to appeal the terms of the approval or his decisions under sub-regulations (A) to (C), before an appeals committee in accordance with Section 9 of the Law.

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Provisions for Refused Products

9. Should the appeal committee decide to reject the appeal, it shall resolve what is to be done with the Animal Product refused for export.

Validity

10. These regulations shall become effective on June 1, 1998.
