THE PESTICIDES ACT

THE PESTICIDES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1999

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Pesticides Control Authority by section 16 of the Pesticides Act, the following Regulations are hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pesticides (Amendment) Regulations, 1999 and shall be read and construed as one with the Pesticides Regulations, 1996, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 8 (2) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the numeral "0.5" and substituting therefor the numeral "1".

THE PESTICIDES ACT**THE PESTICIDES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES) ORDER, 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by sections 9 (2) and 14 (2) of the Pesticides Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made, after consultation with the Pesticides Control Authority:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pesticides Act (Amendment of Schedules) Order, 1999 and shall be read and construed as one with the Pesticides Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.
2. The provisions of the principal Act specified in the first column of the Schedule are amended in the manner specified in the second column thereof.
