AN ACT to Amend the Parishes Water Supply Law.

[13th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Parishes Water Supply (Amendment) Act, 1974, and shall be read and construed as one with the Parishes Water Supply Law (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto.

2—Section 24 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor—

24—The Parish Councils in the several parishes of this Island, in charge of public water supplies, are hereby empowered, if

they think fit, and subject to such orders as they may make—

- (a) to supply water, free of water rates or other charge for the same, in any area by any means other than service pipes; and
- (b) to supply water at cost by means of service pipes to public educational institutions offering primary education as defined in the Education Act, 1965.”.

3—(1) Section 25 of the principal Law is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by inserting therein immediately after the words “to supply” the words “at cost”; and
- (b) by deleting all the words appearing after the word “water” and substituting therefor the words “to public educational institutions offering primary education as defined in the Education Act, 1965 in the parishes of Kingston and Saint Andrew which are within the limits of their water service”.

(2) Nothing in subsection (1) shall be considered as implying that the marginal note is to be regarded as being part of the principal Law.
