**THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION ACT**

**THE WILD LIFE (CLOSE AND SHOOTING SEASONS) ORDER, 1995**

In exercise of the power conferred on the Minister by section 2 of the Wild Life Protection Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wild Life (Close and Shooting Seasons) Order 1995.
2. The hunting of birds of any kind specified in the First Part of the Second Schedule to the Act is prohibited during the continuation of the 1995 close season, that is to say, the period from the commencement of this Order, and ending on the 18th day of August, 1995, and the period commencing on the 25th day of September, 1995, and ending on the 31st day of December, 1995, and accordingly, for the year

1995, the shooting season for birds of any kind specified in the First Part of the Second Schedule to the Act (other than birds specified in paragraph 4 of this Order) shall, subject to paragraph 3 of this Order, be the period commencing on the 20th day of August, 1994, and ending on the 24th day of September, 1995.

3. During the shooting season the following birds, Longtailed Peadove (*Zenaida macroura*), Baldpate (*Columba leucocephala*), Whitewing (*Zenaida asiatica*) may lawfully be hunted only on Saturdays between sunrise and 9:00 a.m. and between 2:30 p.m. and sunset and on Sundays, between sunrise and 9:00 a.m.

4. During the shooting season specified in paragraph 2, ducks (all migratory species), Ground Dove (*Columbigallina passerina*), Whitebelly (*Leptotila jamaicensis*), Caribbean Coot (*Fulica caribaea*), American Coot (*Fulica americana*), Snipe (*Charadrius wilsonia*), Plover or Lapwing (*Squatarola squatarola*) may not lawfully be hunted on any day.

5. The Wild Life (Close and Shooting Seasons) Order, 1994, is hereby revoked.
