AN ACT to Amend the Pesticides Act.

[ 14th February, 1996 ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pesticides (Amendment) Act, 1996, and shall be read and construed as one with the Pesticides Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.
