THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION REGULATIONS, 1960

(Made by the Governor in Council on the 31st day of July, 1960)

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wild Life Protection Regulations, 1960.
2. The maximum number of game birds which may be shot by any person in any one day is forty, that is, twenty game birds during the morning and twenty game birds during the evening.
3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars or in default of payment thereof to imprisonment with hard labour for a period not exceeding three months.
