MEDICINES (BLUETONGUE VACCINE EXEMPTION) (JERSEY) ORDER 2009

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Articles 14 and 110 of the Medicines (Jersey) Law 1995¹, after consultation, under Article 4(2) of the Law, with the Minister for Economic Development and, under Article 110(4) of the Law, with the Medicines Advisory Council and with such other organisations as appear to the Minister to be representative of interests likely to be substantially affected by the Order, orders as follows –

1 Importation of Bluetongue Serotype 1 Vaccine permitted

The restrictions imposed by Article 8(3) of the Medicines (Jersey) Law 1995² shall not apply to the importation of Bluetongue Serotype 1 Vaccine by –

- (a) the Veterinary Officer, as defined by the Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956³; or
- (b) a recognized veterinary surgeon, as defined by the Veterinary Surgeons (Jersey) Law 1999⁴.
