SEA FISHERIES (BAG LIMITS) (JERSEY) ORDER 2016

*Made**1st July 2016**Coming into force**5th July 2016*

THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT, in pursuance of Article 2(4B) of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994¹ and Regulation 3 of the Sea Fisheries (Bag Limits) (Jersey) Regulations 2016², orders as follows –

1 Bag limits per person

- (1) The maximum number of fish that may be taken by any person on any day is as follows –
 - (a) in the case of bass (*Dicentrarchus labrax*), 1 fish;
 - (b) in the case of ormer (*Haliotis tuberculata*), 20 fish.
- (2) However, this Article does not apply to the taking of bass by any person on –
 - (a) a British fishing boat; or
 - (b) a French fishing boat,

in any part of the territorial sea in which the boat is authorized to fish under the Sea Fisheries (Licensing of Fishing Boats) (Jersey) Regulations 2003³.

2 Bag limits per vessel

The maximum number of ormer (*Haliotis tuberculata*) that may be taken by any vessel on any day is 100.

3 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Bag Limits) (Jersey) Order 2016 and shall come into force on 5th July 2016.
