## **EU LEGISLATION (AQUATIC ANIMAL HEALTH – AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS) (JERSEY) ORDER 2017**

*Made*

*24th January 2017*

*Coming into force*

*1st February 2017*

**THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT**, in pursuance of Regulation 34 of the EU Legislation (Aquatic Animal Health) (Jersey) Regulations 2016<sup>1</sup>, orders as follows –

### **1 Interpretation**

In this Order the “principal Regulations” means the EU Legislation (Aquatic Animal Health) (Jersey) Regulations 2016<sup>2</sup>.

### **2 Regulation 1 amended**

In Regulation 1(1) of the principal Regulations, in the definition “inspector” for the words “Diseases of Animals (Jersey) Law 1956<sup>3</sup>” there are substituted the words “Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016<sup>4</sup>”.

### **3 Regulation 31 substituted**

For Regulation 31 of the principal Regulations there is substituted the following Regulation –

#### **“31 Powers of enforcement under Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016**

- (1) Articles 16 to 22 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016<sup>5</sup> apply to and in relation to an aquaculture animal as if –
  - (a) Parts 2 to 5 of these Regulations, Commission Regulation 1251/2008 and every relevant EU instrument were ‘relevant legislation’ within the meaning of that Law; and
  - (b) an Order had been made under Articles 2(2), 4(2) and 17(8) of that Law, for the purposes of Articles 16 to 22 of that Law –

- 
- (i) extending the definition ‘disease’, in Article 2(1) of that Law, to include notifiable diseases,
    - (ii) extending the definition ‘animal’, in Article 4(1) of that Law, to include aquaculture animals, and
    - (iii) specifying notifiable diseases as diseases to which Article 17 of that Law applies.
  - (2) Article 29 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 applies to a person who contravenes a requirement of an aquaculture notice as it applies in relation to a person who contravenes a requirement of a notice served under the ‘relevant legislation’ within the meaning of that Law.
  - (3) For the purpose of paragraph (2) an ‘aquaculture notice’ is a notice served under Article 17(6), 20(1)(j), 20(3) or 22(2)(c) of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 as those Articles are applied by paragraph (1) in relation to aquaculture animals.”.

#### **4 Regulation 32 amended**

At the end of Regulation 32 of the principal Regulations there is added the following paragraph –

- “(5) Paragraphs (1) to (7) and (10) of Article 23 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016<sup>6</sup> apply to a notice under this Regulation as they apply to a notice under the ‘relevant legislation’ for the purpose of that Law.”.

#### **5 Regulation 33 substituted**

For Regulation 33 of the principal Regulations there is substituted the following Regulation –

##### **“33 Obstruction**

- (1) Article 27 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016<sup>7</sup> applies in relation to an aquaculture animal as if the references to ‘relevant legislation’ in that Article included references to these Regulations, Commission Regulation 1251/2008 and every relevant EU instrument.
- (2) Article 29 of the Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016 applies to a person who contravenes Article 27 of that Law as applied by paragraph (1), as it applies to a person who contravenes a requirement of the ‘relevant legislation’ within the meaning of that Law.”.

**6 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the EU Legislation (Aquatic Animal Health – Amendment of Regulations) (Jersey) Order 2017, and comes into force on 1st February 2017.
