

THE BRANDING OF STOCK ACT
(Cap. 357)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Branding of Stock Act, the Minister for Livestock and Fisheries Development, makes the following regulations:—

THE BRANDING OF STOCK ACT (DOMINANT LETTERS) ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Branding of Stock (Dominant Letters) Order, 2006.
2. The Second Schedule of the Branding of Stock Act is amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following new Schedule therefor:
