

## **DECLARATION OF PROHIBITED EXPORTS UNDER SECTION 45**

[L.N. 181/1979.]

**1.** Subject to paragraphs 2 and 3, the following trophies are prohibited exports—

- (a) trophies of the protected animals specified in the Third Schedule to the Act;
- (b) elephant tusks;
- (c) hippopotamus teeth;
- (d) rhinoceros horns;
- (e) crocodile, leopard, lion and zebra skins.

**2.** The items specified in subparagraph (b) to (e) inclusive of paragraph 1 may be exported by agents for foreign principals where the items have been—

- (a) purchased from the Government;
- (b) held prior to export in Government bonded warehouse;
- (c) at all times prior to export processed, handled and loaded by authorized servants or agents of the Government; and
- (d) paid for in foreign currency.

**3.** Nothing in this notice shall prevent the export of any trophy lawfully acquired by any person where the trophy is part of the personal or household effects of that person and is not intended to be resold, or otherwise dealt with for gain, and that person otherwise complies with all relevant provisions of the Act.
