

THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT) ACT

(No. 47 of 2013)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 116 (2) (b) of the Wildlife Conservation and Management Act, 2013, the Cabinet Secretary for Tourism and Wildlife makes the following regulations—

**THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT)
(NATIONAL PARKS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and shall take effect from the 1st July, 2019.

2. The Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) Regulations, 2013 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations” is amended in section 2 and part II of the Schedule by-

- (a) Deleting the entry fees in paragraph 1(a) of part II and substituting therefor the following new fees:-
