LEGAL NOTICE NO. 34

**THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT
ACT, 2013**

(No. 47 of 2013)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Wildlife Conservation and Management Act, 2013, the Cabinet Secretary for Tourism and Wildlife makes the following Regulations—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022. Citation.
2. The Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) Regulations, 2013, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”, are amended in regulation 2 by— L.N. 1/2014.
 - (a) deleting the definition of “daily fee” and substituting therefor the following new definition—

“daily fee” means the fee paid for a single entry to a National Park, National Reserve or Sanctuary and which shall be valid for not longer than twenty-four hours;
 - (b) inserting the following new definitions in proper alphabetical sequence—

“high season” means the period between the 1st July of one year and the 29th February of the following year;

“low season” means the period between the 1st March of one year and the 30th June of the following year; and

“student” means an individual from a recognized secondary school, Government or private college or university who is not older than twenty-three years visiting a National Park, National Reserve or Sanctuary for educational purposes under a documented and organised arrangement with that school, college or university but not a student on a personally-arranged visit.
3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4 by adding the following new subregulation immediately after subregulation (3)—
 - (4) Any payments made under these Regulations in respect of any matter set out in the Schedule shall be made through the KWS Zurupay App and shall be cashless.
4. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting Part II of the Schedule and substituting therefor the following new Part—

**PART II—FEES FOR ENTRY INTO NATIONAL PARKS,
NATIONAL RESERVES OR SANCTUARIES MANAGED BY THE
KENYA WILDLIFE SERVICE**
