

# **GOVERNMENT LANDS (REGISTRATION) RULES**

[Cap. 155 (1948), Sub. Leg., L.N. 346/1960.]

1. These Rules may be cited as the Government Lands (Registration) Rules.

(1) The Registrar shall refuse to register any assignment of a lease issued under the Act where the premium reserved by such lease is payable to the Government by instalments, unless and until the head lease thereof is produced duly endorsed by the Commissioner of Lands, as provided for in subsection (4) of section 24 of the Act.

(2) The Registrar shall not take cognizance of an endorsement under paragraph (1) unless and until the same has been duly registered under the Act.

3. Powers of attorney registrable under section 108 of the Act, and revocations of such powers, shall be registered in a special volume of the registry kept for the purpose.
