On Organisation of Auction Sale of some types of agricultural raw materials in the Kyrgyz Republic

The Government of the Kyrgyz Republic indicates, that tendency on reduction of some types of agricultural raw materials is being observed in the Republic.

Because of absence of marketing services and information on prices for agricultural raw materials, agricultural commodity producers sell them very cheaply to commercial units, as a result Republic and local budgets incur perceptible losses.

In order to excite the interest of agricultural commodity producers in increase of agricultural raw materials production the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic decrees :

1. Heads of oblast administrations, MAWR shall establish in oblasts auction centers for sale of agricultural products.
2. To oblige all agricultural commodity producers of the Republic irrespective of the property type excluding peasant farms working on the family basis :
 - to carry out sale of wool, cotton, tobacco and grain through specialized auctions excluding commodities for which agreements had been signed (on the basis of international agreements) and future transactions.
 - in case of exporting of wool, cotton, tobacco and grain they should submit to the State Customs Inspection under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic all the minutes (protocols) of the auction sales.
3. Ministry of Economics of the Kyrgyz Republic, Ministry of Industry, Trade and Entrepreneurship of the Kyrgyz Republic and MAWR of the Kyrgyz Republic iwithin two weeks time to develop and submit for approval to the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic :
 - Regulations on the procedures of auctions;
 - Regulations on and future transactions.
4. Heads of oblast administrations shall ensure functioning of the special auctions.
5. To charge the Government Apparatus with the powers to exercise control over the implementation of this Resolution.
