 - Head of State Veterinary Inspection of Veterinary Department U. Orozov
3. To charge Mr. Kadyrkulov with the control over the execution of the present order.

INTERIM PROVISION ON ORGANIZATION OF ZOOVETSERVICES FOR INDIVIDUAL AND PEASANT FARMS AND OTHER FARMING ENTITIES IN AGRICULTURE

1. GENERAL

1.1 In the course of implementation of Land and Agrarian Reform new peasant and individual farms were organized on the basis of the reorganized kolkhozes and sovkhoses. The private owned population of livestock increased.

The former zoovetsystem was destroyed and many of the state zooveteterinary points, hospitals were reduced.

1.2 In view of creation of adequate conditions for the effective agricultural production and according with the provisions of Law on Veterinary and Law on Livestock Breeding the Interim Provision on zoovetservices is developed.

1.3 Veterinarians, zootechnicians and zooengineers specially trained have a right to render zooveterinary services as well as other farming entities with special provisions in their Charters foreseeing their zooveterinary activity coordinated with the Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

1.4 Local Administrations, Agricultural Departments will be entrusted with the organization of zoovetservices on the base of the reorganized kolkhozes and sovkhoses, breeding farms, rayon veterinary stations and points, artificial insemination branches.

2. FUNCTIONS OF ZOOVETSERVICES

2.1 Zoovetservices will perform the following activity in livestock-breeding:

- artificial insemination;
- determination of quality and fat content of milk;
- organization of sheep shearing and clipping;
- determination of output of clean wool fiber;
- laboratory analysis of wool samples;
- trial and training of horses;
- organization of cultivated pastures and their utilization;
- fodder preparation technology and feeding;
- definition of chemical composition, quality and nutrition value of fodder;
- livestock production technology and processing;
- assistance to installation and assembling of livestock equipment;
- intermediary services in purchase of livestock equipment and machinery;
- development of selection programs and forms of husbandry registration;
- export and import of services, commodities and marketing service;

- creation of network of branches of mixed companies of production, trade and other prescription;
- all the required services re zootechnical service and science.

3. FUNCTIONS OF VETERINARY SERVICES

- 3.1 Surgery operations
- 3.2 Gynecological assistance.
- 3.2 Preventive vaccination, treatment;
- 3.3 Advisory assistance to farmers re: feeding, keeping, prevention of infectious and noninfectious diseases;
- 3.4 Diagnostic examination including biochemical methods;
- 3.5 Complex veterinary services of individual farms and populated areas on the base of contracts with the owners or local authorities.
- 3.6 Paid antiepidemiological and other measures;
- 3.7 Preparation and sale of veterinary drugs.

4. PROCEDURE OF LICENSING OF ZOOVETERINARY ACTIVITY

According to Decree of President of 19.06.1992, No Y 11 -207, all kinds of private zooveterinary activity are subject to licensing.

License to render zooveterinary services are issued by the Commission of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

Citizens with higher and secondary zooveterinary education and practical skills and farming entities with special provisions in their Charters foreseeing zooveterinary activity have a right to be engaged in zooveterinary activity.

the following documents are required to get a license:

- 4.1 Application for a license (sample is enclosed);
- 4.2 Certificate on State registration of business and zooveterinary activity;
- 4.3 Charter of an enterprise.
- 4.4 Conclusion on the correspondence of production conditions with the sanitary and veterinary standards and requirements;
- 4.4 Conclusion on the correspondence of an enterprise re production, storage and sale of veterinary drugs;
- 4.5 Documents on adequate equipment and tools availability;

4.7 An Applicant is responsible for the authenticity of the data supplied;

4.9 Decision on dismissal or issue of license is to be made by the Commission of the Ministry. Dismissal or issue of license can be appealed against by the Ministry of Agriculture.

4.10 Farming entities and specialist possess a right to render zooveterinary assistance from the moment of license issue.

4.11 License validity term is 5 years.

5. PROCEDURE OF CERTIFICATION OF LEGAL ENTITIES AND CITIZENS

5.1 Commission is responsible for certification of farming entities and specialists.

5.2 Persons without special zooveterinary education must not be engaged in zooveterinary activity.
