Regulation No. 217

Adopted 27 June 2000

List of Goods Subject to Control by the Sanitary Border Inspection and Control Procedures

Issued pursuant to Section 114,
Paragraph two of the Customs Law

1. These Regulations determine the list of goods subject to control by the Sanitary Border Inspection, and the procedures by which the veterinary control of goods crossing the State (customs) border and of the means of transport carrying such goods is conducted and how compliance with the mandatory harmlessness and security requirements is controlled.
2. Within the scope of their competence, officials of the Sanitary Border Inspection shall:
 - 2.1. carry out veterinary control of the goods listed in Annex 1 of these Regulations:
 - 2.1.1. upon importation of goods into the territory of the Republic of Latvia (also into the free zone) from the territory of another state;
 - 2.1.2. upon exportation of goods from the territory of the Republic of Latvia to the territory of another state; and
 - 2.1.3. if the goods are stored in customs warehouses; and
 - 2.2. control compliance of the goods listed in Annex 2 of these Regulations with mandatory harmlessness and security requirements:
 - 2.2.1. upon importation of goods from the territory of another state, free zone or customs warehouse for free circulation, duty-free shop or processing; and
 - 2.2.2. if the goods are stored in customs warehouses.
3. The control referred to in Paragraph 2 of these Regulations shall be carried out for payment in accordance with a price list approved by the Minister for Agriculture.
4. Payment for control shall not be collected:
 - 4.1. if control is applied to goods that are transported by transit through the territory of the Republic of Latvia with a TIR carnet or a transit declaration (with or without unloading, with or without storing in customs warehouses, free zones and free ports);
 - 4.2. if control is applied to goods that are moved into customs warehouses, free zones and free ports (with or without processing) in order to move such out of the Republic of Latvia by transit or re-exportation; and
 - 4.3. if control is applied to means of transport that carry goods referred to in Sub-paragraphs 4.1 and 4.2 of these Regulations.
5. The conditions referred to in Paragraph 4 of these Regulations shall not apply to:
 - 5.1. control that is carried out outside specified working hours or the workplace; and
 - 5.2. control of goods listed in Annex 1.
6. In order to ensure the control referred to in Paragraph 2 of these Regulations, officials of the Sanitary Border Inspection shall:

6.1. carry out inspection of goods crossing the State (customs) border, and the means of transport carrying such goods;

6.2. carry out expert-examination of the confirmation and attestation of conformity assessment (if such document is required by law or other regulatory enactments), the veterinary certificate and other accompanying documents;

6.3. take samples for laboratory examination, if there is cause for suspicion of non-conformity of the actual goods to the goods indicated in the documents, or of non-compliance of such with mandatory harmless and security requirements, and, if necessary, hold the goods until receipt of the results of the laboratory examination; and

6.4. examine quarantine documents and other documents, take the necessary anti-epidemic, anti-epizootic measures and issue permits for the entry of means of transport and importation of goods into the Republic of Latvia and exportation from it.

7. The control referred to in Paragraph 2 of these Regulations shall be mandatory, and a means of transport with goods may not cross the State (customs) border before relevant control is carried out.

8. If information has been received, or there is cause for suspicion that goods or a means of transport contain dangerous infection agents or other dangerous organisms, or a quarantine has been determined, veterinary control or a control of compliance with mandatory harmless and security requirements shall be carried out before border control, customs control or any other control.

9. The following are repealed:

9.1. Cabinet Regulation No. 236 of 1 July 1997, Regulations Regarding Procedures for Veterinary and Sanitary Hygiene Control of Means of Transport and Freight at Customs Stations (*Latvijas Vēstnesis*, 1997, No. 171/174; 1999, No. 140, 348/350); and

9.2. Cabinet Regulation No. 356 of 19 October 1999, Amendments to the Cabinet Regulations No. 236 of 1 July 1997, Regulations Regarding Procedures for Veterinary, Phytosanitary and Sanitary Hygiene Control of Means of Transport and Freight at Customs Points (*Latvijas Vēstnesis*, 1999, No. 348/350).
