

FISHERIES ACT 1963

FISHERIES (PROHIBITION OF METHOD OF FISHING) REGULATIONS 1980

- Act 210.* IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Fisheries Act 1963, the Minister makes the following regulations:
- Citation.* 1. These regulations may be cited as the *Fisheries (Prohibition of Method of Fishing) Regulations 1980*.
- Prohibition of fishing.* 2. No person shall use for the purpose of fishing or have in his possession or on board any vessel any fishing net, trap, appliance or device described in the Schedule.
- Revocation P.U. (A) 187/71.* 3. The Fisheries (Prohibition of Method of Fishing) Regulations 1971 are revoked.

SCHEDULE

1. Pair trawl net or any fishing net called by whatever name adapted to be towed along the sea bed by two powered boats.
2. Any fishing net or bag of any material, rigged to a rigid frame of any kind, with or without ski-shaped shoe, so as to be towed, pulled, pushed or thrust along the sea bed by a powered boat.
3. Any fishing method using electric current, generated by whatever means, to attract, stun or kill fish.
