FISHERIES (PROHIBITION OF IMPORT, ETC., OF FISH) REGULATIONS 1990

 Act 317
 In exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Fisheries Act 1985, the Minister makes the following regulations:

 Clustion.
 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Prohibition of Import, etc., of Fish) Regulations 1990.

 Prohibition.
 2. (1) No person shall import into, sell, cultivate or keep live fish of the genus as specified in the Schedule to these Regulations except with the written permission of the Director-General.

 (2) The Director-General may impose any conditions he deems fit in the written permission granted pursuant to paragraph (1).

 Penalty.
 3. Any person who contravenes the provision of regulation 2 (1) or any conditions imposed in the written permission granted by the

Director-General under regulation 2 (2) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand ringgit or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding one year or both.
