

**ATOMIC ENERGY LICENSING (EXEMPTION) (CERAMIC FACTORY) ORDER 1998  
PU(A) 431/1998**

**1. Citation.**

This order may be cited as the Atomic Energy Licensing (Exemption) (Ceramic Factory) Order 1998.

**2. Interpretation.**

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires -

"ceramic factory" means ceramic factory

**3. Exemption.**

Every ceramic factory is exempted from the Atomic Energy Licensing Act 1984 subject to the following conditions:

(a) that the factory is registered with the Atomic Energy Licensing Board;

(b) that from the date of its registration, the operation of the factory follows the current guidelines issued by the Atomic Energy Licensing Board; and

(c) that the activity concentration of the radioactive materials contained in zirconium silicate does not exceed the levels as stated in the Table.
