

## PESTICIDES (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2004

PU(A) 13/2004

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Pesticides Act 1974 [*Act 149*], the Minister makes the following order:

### 1. Citation.

This order may be cited as the **Pesticides (Exemption) Order 2004**.

### 2. Exemption.

Any person who sell or store for sale pesticides of classes II, III and IV specified in the Schedule are exempted from subsections 20(1) and (2) of the Act.

### 3. Revocation.

The Pesticides (Exemption) Order 2002 [*P.U. (A) 107/2002*] is revoked.

## SCHEDULE

Insecticidal aerosols

Animal ear tags

*Bacillus thuringensis* variety *israelensis* serotype H-14 containing 200 I.T.U/mg

*Bacillus thuringensis* subsp *israelensis* serotype H-14 containing 1200 I.T.U/mg

Liquid (spot on) for the control of ticks and fleas on dogs and cats

Liquid mosquito repellent for vaporizing

Insecticide impregnated net or paper

Mosquito repellent mats

Mosquito repellent coils

Lotions for control of lice, fleas and mites on dogs and cats

Insect repellent

0.5% or less w/w permethrin powder

1% or less w/w temephos granules

Collars for the control of ticks and fleas on dogs and cats

Soap for pets

Powder for the control of ticks and fleas on dogs and cats

Shampoo for the control of lice, fleas and mites on dogs and cats

Tablets for the control of cockroach

Fly, cockroach or ant baits
