

PESTICIDES (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2008

PU(A) 353/2008

IN exercise of the powers conferred by subsection 57(1) of the **Pesticides Act 1974**[*Act 149*], the Minister, after consulting the Board, makes the following rules:

1. Citation and commencement

- (1) These rules may be cited as the **Pesticides (Registration) (Amendment) Rules 2008**.
- (2) These Rules come into operation on 1 January 2009.

2. Amendment of rule 3

The **Pesticides (Registration) Rules 2005**[*P.U. (A) 302/2005*], which are referred to as the "principal Rules" in the these Rules, are amended in subrule 3(1) by substituting for the words "three thousand" the words "one thousand five hundred".

3. Substitution of rule 4

The principal Rules are amended by substituting for the rule 4 the following rule:-

"Registration fee

4. The fees for registration or re-registration of a pesticide according to the class assigned to the pesticide as specified in subsubparagraph 4(j)(i) of the **Pesticides (Labelling) Regulations 1984**[*P.U. (A) 251/1984*] are as follows:-

- (a) three thousand five hundred ringgit for the class Ia and class Ib pesticides;
- (b) two thousand ringgit for the class II pesticides;
- (c) one thousand ringgit for the class III pesticides; and
- (d) five hundred ringgit for the class IV pesticides,

and is payable prior to the issuance of the certificate of registration."

4. Amendment of Schedule

The Schedule to the principal Rules is amended in Form A under the heading of "**PART G: DECLARATION**" in paragraph 32, by substituting for the words "RM3,000.00 (three thousand ringgit)" the words "RM1,500.00 (one thousand five hundred ringgit)".

5. Saving provision

(1) The fee for an application for registration or re-registration of a pesticide and the fees prescribed for the certificate of registration or re-registration of a pesticide, where the registration or re-registration was made under the principal Rules before the appointed date but is not determined or registered by the Board before the appointed date shall, after the appointed date, continue to apply as if the principal Rules has not been amended by these Rules.

(2) For the purpose of this rule "appointed date " means the date mentioned under subrule 1(2).
