THE LAND SURVEYORS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 20 of the Land Surveyors Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Land Surveyors (Diplomas) Regulations 2011**.
- 2.** For the purposes of section 5(1)(b)(ii) of the Land Surveyors Act, the qualifications set out in the Schedule to these regulations shall be the appropriate qualifications.
- 3.** The Land Surveyors (Diplomas) Regulations 1979 are revoked.
