

Bread (Control of Manufacture and Sale) (Amendment) Regulations 2013

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THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 3 and 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Bread (Control of Manufacture and Sale) (Amendment) Regulations 2013**.

2. In these regulations —
“principal regulations” means the Bread (Control of Manufacture and Sale) Regulations 1988.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definition —

“bread” means a type of bread referred to in the first column of the Schedule which is made from white wheaten flour or whole wheat flour;

4. The Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Schedule to these regulations.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 2013.
