

Mauritius Standards Bureau (National Management Systems Certification Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2017

THE MAURITIUS STANDARDS BUREAU ACT

Regulations made by the Council under section 33 of the Mauritius Standards Bureau Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mauritius Standards Bureau (National Management Systems Certification Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2017.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Mauritius Standards Bureau (National Management

Systems Certification Scheme) Regulations 2008.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended -

(a) in the definition of "National Management Systems Certification Scheme", by

adding the following new paragraph, the comma at the end of paragraph (e)

being deleted and replaced by a semi colon -

(f) the Mauritius Standards Bureau, National Sustainable Tourism

Management System Certification Scheme (NSTMSCS) relating to MS

165,

(b) by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definition -

"MS 165" means the Mauritius Standard for Sustainable Tourism requirements

declared under section 18 of the Act;

4. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words "and MS

OHSAS 18001" and replacing them by the words ", MS OHSAS 18001 and MS 165".

5. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First

Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

6. These regulations shall come into operation on 28 February 2017.

(2) The registered firm symbols -

(a) shall be of the shape as in the above design;

(b) may be larger or smaller than in the design but its parts shall keep the same proportions as in the design;

(c) may appear in any colour provided the colour is uniform throughout
