

**Fisheries and Marine Resources (Licence and Fees) (Amendment) Regulations  
2017**

**THE FISHERIES AND MARINE RESOURCES ACT  
Regulations made by the Minister under section 74(1)(k) of  
the Fisheries and Marine Resources Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Fisheries and Marine Resources (Licence and Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2017**.

2. In these regulations —

“principal regulations” means the Fisheries and Marine Resources (Licence and Fees) Regulations 2013.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition, the full stop at the end of the definition of “purse seiner” being deleted and replaced by a semicolon —

“supply vessel” means a vessel which is involved in —

(a) carrying, deploying, retrieving, searching for, or monitoring a fishing aggregating device;

(b) assisting a fishing vessel with resupplying, changing or transferring crew; or

(c) any other supporting service.

4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new items and their corresponding entries —

8.	Mauritian supply vessel	USD 4,000	per annum
		USD 1,000	for every additional period of 90 days
9.	Foreign supply vessel	USD 5,000	per annum
		USD 1,250	for every additional period of 90 days
