(PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of  
the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Control of Sale of Imported Live Animals for Home Slaughter) (Amendment) Regulations 2017.**

2. In these regulations —  
‘principal regulations’ means the Consumer Protection (Control of Sale of Imported Live Animals for Home Slaughter) Regulations 2010.

3. Regulation 6A of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation —

**6A.** (1) The retail selling price of live cattle imported from South Africa shall, during the specified period, not exceed 135 rupees per kilogramme.

(2) In this regulation —

‘specified period’ means the period starting from 4 August 2017 to the day following 2 days after the religious ceremony of Eid-UI-Adha in the year of 2017.

4. These regulations shall come into operation on 4 August 2017.
