THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT

Regulation made by the District Council of Black River under section 50, 61,158 and 163

of the Local Government Act 2011.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the District Council of Black River (Collection and Disposal of Refuse) Amendment Regulations 2017.

2. In these regulations:

“Principal Regulations” means The District Council of Black River (Collection and Disposal of Refuse) Regulations 2013 published under government Notice No. 42 of 2014 as subsequently amended.

3. The Principal Regulations is amended:

A) In Regulation 2:

(a) By deleting the interpretation of “gated community” and replacing the definition as follows:-

“Gated Community” means a private residential Community : -

- (i) Comprising of at least 10 lots of residential units;
- (ii) Having a defined geographic area and extent, irrespective of whether the residential community has a controlled access or not; and

(iii) Being managed by a syndic responsible for the maintenance of all common infrastructures such as roads, drains, and street lighting

within the residential community.

(b) by inserting, after the words “gated community” in the interpretation of “syndic”, the words “or any other specific residential area or commercial complex”

B) In Regulation 4:

by inserting after the word “owner” in regulation 4, the words “or syndic”

4. These regulations shall come into force on its date of publication.
