**THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 79 of the Public Health Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Prevention and Mitigation of Infectious Disease (Coronavirus) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2020**.
2. In these regulations –  
  
“principal regulations” means the Prevention and Mitigation of Infectious Disease (Coronavirus) Regulations 2020.
3. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (4) and replacing it by the following paragraph –  
  
(4) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to –
  - (a) a person who has to avail himself of medical treatment, or procure essential supplies, food stuff, medicine or any other item essential for his or his family’s subsistence or livelihood;
  - (b) a Judge or Magistrate for the purpose of attending Court;
  - (c) a barrister or an attorney whose services have been retained by a person to attend a police station, place of detention or Court;
  - (d) a medical practitioner for the purpose of attending a hospital, private medical institution or patient in need of urgent medical care;
  - (e) a pharmacist for the purpose of attending his place of work.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 26 April 2020.
