Maritime Zones (Exclusive Economic Zones) Regulations 1984

27th December, 1984

Regulations made by the Prime Minister under Section 15 of the Maritime Zones Act 1977

These regulations may be cited as the Maritime Zones (Exclusive Economic Zones) Regulations 1984.

The exclusive economic zones falling within the jurisdiction of Mauritius extend and have always extended from the base lines of the territory of Mauritius within the coordinates specified in the First and Second Schedules.

These regulations are without prejudice to the continental shelf of Mauritius as defined in the Maritime Zones Act, 1977.

Made at Port Louis by Prime Minister on 27 December 1984.

First Schedule (Regulation 2)

Geographical Coordinates adopted to designate the limits of the exclusive economic zones for the Islands of Mauritius, Rofrigues, Cargados Caragos (St. Brandon), Agalega and Tromelin.

Second Schedule (regulation 2)

Geographical Coordinates adopted to designate the limits of the exclusive economic zones for Chagos Archipelago.
