Dangerous Chemicals Control (Fees) Regulations 2005

THE DANGEROUS CHEMICALS CONTROL ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 10, 11 and 35 of the Dangerous Chemicals Control Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Dangerous Chemicals Control (Fees) Regulations 2005**.
- 2.** In these regulations-

"Act" means the Dangerous Chemicals Control Act 2004.
- 3.** Where a licence is granted or renewed under the Act for the import or export of a dangerous chemical, the applicant shall pay to the Board the fees specified in paragraph 1 of the Schedule.
- 4.** Where a licence is granted or renewed under the Act for the manufacture, sale, storage, distribution or trading in of a dangerous chemical, the applicant shall pay to the Board the fees specified in paragraph 2 of the Schedule.
- 5.** Where a permit is granted or renewed under the Act for the import or export of a pesticide or an extremely dangerous chemical, the applicant shall pay to the Board the fees specified in paragraph 3 of the Schedule.
- 6.** These regulations shall come into operation on 21 March, 2005

3.	Issue of a permit or the renewal of a permit for the import or export of a pesticide or an extremely dangerous chemical.	100
