

Plant and Animal Quarantine Regulations

PART V - SPECIFIC PLANT PROHIBITIONS

42. Plant Quarantines - Specific plant prohibitions

(a) Plants and plant materials listed in Schedule I to these regulations may be imported into the FSM from a place outside the FSM, subject to the specific prohibitions set forth in the third column of Schedule I.

(b) Plants and plant materials listed in Schedule II to these regulations may be transferred from one State of the FSM to another State of the FSM, subject to the specific prohibitions shown in the third column of Schedule II.
