

## **CHAPTER 7 LEASE OF PUBLIC LANDS TO CITIZENS**

### **§301. Authority to lease; forms; criteria.**

The district administrator of each administrative district is hereby empowered and authorized to execute leases and other use agreements of public land to Trust Territory citizens or corporations or other business associations wholly owned by citizens of the Trust Territory for periods of not more than twenty-five years, including renewals. Such leases or other use agreements shall be on forms approved by the Attorney General, and shall be granted in accordance with the policies established by law or by regulations issued by the land and claims administrator and approved by the High Commissioner; provided, that such regulations are consistent with the provisions of this chapter and other laws of the Trust Territory.
