**PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

**Closure of Food and Drink Outlets
(Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2022**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 26 of the Public Health Act, the Minister responsible for public health, after consultation with the Superintendent of Public Health, has made the following regulations:-

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Closure of Food and Drink Outlets (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2022 and these regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Closure of Food and Drink Outlets Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

(2) These regulations shall come into force on 14 February 2022:

Provided that the principal regulations which are being amended by virtue of these regulations shall be deemed to be still in force, even after 14 February 2022, for the purposes of any act, decision, action or proceedings taken in respect of any breach of those regulations.

2. The second proviso to regulation 2 of the principal regulations shall be substituted by the following new proviso:

"Provided further that all bars, clubs, restaurants and kiosks shall only serve food to clients who are seated at a table and according to the standards issued by the Superintendent of Public Health:".
