**IRRIGATION OF CROPS (HEALTH PRECAUTIONS)
REGULATIONS**

16th September, 1988

LEGAL NOTICE 71 of 1988.

- 1.** The title of these Regulations is Irrigation of Crops (Health Precautions) Regulations. Title.
 - 2.** No person may irrigate any field, where crops intended for human consumption are, or may be, cultivated, with any sewage or sewage contaminated water. Prohibition of irrigation with sewage.
 - 3.** It shall be lawful for the Superintendent of Public Health to order the seizure and/or destruction of crops which have been irrigated with sewage or sewage contaminated water. Seizure and destruction.
 - 4.** The provisions of regulations 2 and 3 of these Regulations shall not apply to any field irrigated with effluent from sewage which has been treated and purified at a government-run sewage treatment plant in respect of such crops which the Superintendent of Public Health has approved could be cultivated in such field. Saving.
