

**L.N. 40 of 2004**

**FOOD SAFETY ACT  
(CAP. 449)**

***Kava-Kava* Regulations, 2004**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 10 of the Food Safety Act, the Minister of Health has made the following regulations:

Citation.

**1.** The title of these regulations is the *Kava-Kava* Regulations, 2004.

Interpretation.

**2.** In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

“*Kava-Kava*” means a plant, or any part of or an extract from a plant, belonging to the species *Piper methysticum*.

“food” includes:

(a) food supplements, as defined in the Food Supplements Regulations, 2003, and

(b) non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages,

but shall not include medicinal products, as defined under the Medicines Act.

Prohibition of sale of food consisting of or containing *Kava-Kava*.

**3.** No person shall manufacture, sell or import into Malta any food consisting of, or containing, *Kava-Kava*.
