**ECO-CONTRIBUTION ACT, 2004
(ACT NO. XII OF 2004)**

Designation of the Competent Authority Order, 2004

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 10 of the Eco-Contribution Act, 2004, the Minister for Rural Affairs and the Environment has designated the Commissioner of Value Added Tax, hereinafter referred to as “the Commissioner”, as the Competent Authority for the purposes of the Act, to carry out the functions of the Competent Authority under the said Act.

In the exercise of such functions:

(a) the Commissioner may delegate to any public officer any of the rights, duties, powers and other functions vested in him, conferred to him or imposed upon him by the Act or in virtue of any regulations made thereunder; and

(b) the Commissioner may delegate to any such person such of the rights, duties, powers and other functions vested in him, conferred to him or imposed upon him by the Act or in virtue of any regulations made thereunder as the Minister responsible for waste management strategy implementation may direct in writing:

Provided that the Commissioner may not delegate those rights, duties, powers and other functions vested in him if such person is not considered by the Commissioner as a fit and proper person to exercise those rights, duties, powers and other functions.
