Plant Protection Products (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations,
2007

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 4 and 5 of the Pesticides Control Act, the Minister for Rural Affairs and the Environment has made the following regulations:–

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Plant Protection Products (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations, 2007 and they shall be read and construed as one with the Plant Protection Products Regulations, 2004, hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”. Title and scope.

(2) The scope of these regulations is to transpose the European Commission Directive 2007/21/EC, Commission Directive 2007/31/EC and Commission Directive 2006/45/EC amending Annex I of Directive 91/414/EEC.

2. (1) In Schedule IV to the principal regulations in the rows for ‘Imazalil’, ‘Azoxystrobin’, ‘Kresoxim-Methyl’, ‘Spiroxamine’, ‘Azimsulfuron’, ‘Fluroxypyr’ and ‘Prohexadione Calcium’, the expiry date shall be substituted with “31 December 2011”. Amends Schedule IV to the principal regulations.

(2) In Schedule IV to the principal regulations, for item No. 69, ‘Fosthiazate’, there shall be substituted the following:

No	Common Name	Inclusion Directive	Date of Implementation (*)
“69	Fosthiazate	Directive 2007/31/EC	2 September 2007”.

(3) In Schedule IV to the principal regulations for item No. 77, ‘Propoxycarbazone’, there shall be substituted the following:

B 3424

"77	Propoxycarbazone	Directive 2006/45/EC	19 September 2006".
