

L.N. 217 of 2009**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(CAP. 427)****Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for Energy-Using Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2009**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 38 to 40 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister of Finance, the Economy and Investment, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, has made the following regulations:-

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for Energy-Using Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2009 and they shall be read and construed as one with the Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for Energy-Using Products Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

Title and Scope

(2) These regulations apply to the requirements of the following:

(a) Commission Regulation (EC) No 1275/2008 of 17 December 2008 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for standby and off mode electric power consumption of electrical and electronic household and office equipment.

(b) Commission Regulation (EC) No 107/2009 of 4 February 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for simple set-top boxes.

(c) Commission Regulation (EC) No 244/2009 of 18 March 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for non-directional household lamps.

(d) Commission Regulation (EC) No 245/2009 of 18 March 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for fluorescent lamps without integrated ballast, for high intensity discharge lamps, and for ballasts and luminaries able to operate such lamps, and repealing Directive

2000/55/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council.

(e) Commission Regulation (EC) No 278/2009 of 6 April 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for no-load condition electric power consumption and average active efficiency of external power supplies.

2. Sub-regulation (2) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations shall be substituted by the following:

"(2) These regulations shall apply to the following energy using products:

(a) Products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 1275/2008 of 17 December 2008 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for standby and off mode electric power consumption of electrical and electronic household and office equipment.

(b) Products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 107/2009 of 4 February 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for simple set-top boxes.

(c) Products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 244/2009 of 18 March 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for non-directional household lamps.

(d) Products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 245/2009 of 18 March 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for fluorescent lamps without integrated ballast, for high intensity discharge lamps, and for ballasts and luminaires able to operate such lamps, and repealing Directive 2000/55/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council.

(e) Products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 278/2009 of 6 April 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European

Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for no-load condition electric power consumption and average active efficiency of external power supplies.

(f) Hot water boilers within the meaning of the Efficiency Requirements for New Hot-Water Boilers Fired with Liquid or Gaseous Fuels (Implementing Measures) Regulations, 2007.

(g) Household refrigerators within the meaning of the Energy Efficiency Requirements for Household Electric Refrigerators, Freezers and Combinations thereof (Implementing Measures) Regulations, 2007.

(h) Ballast for fluorescent lighting within the meaning of the Energy Efficiency Requirements for Ballasts for Fluorescent Lighting (Implementing Measures) Regulations, 2007."
