**Regulations relating to Foot and Mouth Disease Areas and
Restrictions in Connection with Foot and Mouth Disease**

Government Notice 76 of 1964

(OG 2560)

came into force on date of publication: 23 May 1964

The Regulations relating to Foot and Mouth Disease Areas and Restrictions in Connection with Foot and Mouth Disease were originally made in terms of section 27 of the Animal Diseases and Parasites Ordinance 34 of 1959, which was then repealed by the Animal Diseases and Parasites Amendment Act 9 of 1973, which was subsequently repealed by the Animal Health Act 1 of 2011. Pursuant to section 37(2) of the Animal Health Act 1 of 2011, the Regulations relating to Foot and Mouth Disease Areas and Restrictions in Connection with Foot and Mouth Disease are deemed to have been made under that Act.

1. For the purpose of these regulations -
 - (a) the land falling within the areas defined in the schedule hereto shall be known as foot and mouth disease areas;

- (b) “animal products” shall include for the purpose of schedule *one* -
- (i) the skins and hides of cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and other cloven-hoofed animals but shall not include any processed article manufactured from any such product;
 - (ii) the hair, bristles, wool, horns, hoofs, bones, semen, blood and manure of such animals but shall not include any processed article manufactured from any such product;
- (c) “animal products” shall include for the purpose of schedule *two* -
- (i) milk and milk products such as farm butter, farm cheese, cream and casein but shall not include factory-processed articles such as creamery butter, condensed milk, powdered milk products and cheese provided these articles are in intact factory-packaged containers;
 - (ii) the uncooked meat, organs and viscera of cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and other cloven-hoofed animals;
 - (iii) the skins and hides of such animals;
 - (iv) the hair, bristles, wool, horns, hoofs, bones, semen, blood and manure of such animals but shall not include any processed article manufactured from any such product;
- (d) “vegetable products” shall include grass, grasshay, straw, lucerne, hay, maize, stalks and kaffir corn stalks; but shall not include tobacco and its products, industrial timber, basketware, maize, kaffir corn, groundnuts, fruit and vegetables in bags, fruit and vegetables in boxes or crates without straw or grass, and walking sticks, ornaments and curios made of wood;
- (e) “animal” shall include cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or other cloven-hoofed animals;
- (f) “landed property” means any land which is registered in any deeds registry as a separate piece of land, and in respect of the Rehoboth Gebiet, land registered in the land register of the Rehoboth Baster Community.

2. (a) No cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or other cloven-hoofed animals shall be moved out of the foot and mouth areas described in the schedule hereto, except under the authority of a written permit issued by a state veterinarian and subject to such conditions as he may specify in such permit.

(b) No cattle, sheep, goats, pigs or other cloven-hoofed animals shall be moved into the foot and mouth areas described in the schedules hereto, or from any one place to any other place within those areas, except under the authority of a written permit issued by a state veterinarian and subject to such conditions as he may specify in such permit. The provisions of this sub-regulation shall not apply to the movement of such animals from one place to any other place if both such places are on the same landed property.

(c) No animal or vegetable product shall be moved out of the foot and mouth areas described in the schedules hereto, or from one place to any other place within those areas except under the authority of a written permit issued by a state veterinarian and subject to such conditions as he may specify in such permit. The provisions of this subregulation shall not apply

to the movement of animal or vegetable products from one place to any other place if both such places are on the same landed property.

(d) The prohibition imposed by subregulation (c) of regulation 2 shall not apply to the movement of animal and vegetable products within the area of jurisdiction of an urban local authority.

3. Government Notice 210 dated 18th December, 1963, is hereby repealed.

- (i) The Kaokoveld magisterial district.
- (ii) The Ovamboland magisterial district.
- (iii) The Okavango magisterial district.
- (iv) The magisterial districts of Tsumeb, Swakopmund, Walvis Bay, Windhoek, Gobabis and Grootfontein excluding that portion of this district as described in schedule two hereto.
- (v) That portion of Gibeon district bounded as follows: From the southern-most beacon of the farm Lindepas 291, generally northwestwards along the boundaries of the following farms so as to include them in this area: the said Lindepas 291, Guachab 288, Meerpoort 287, Rustig 562, Benoud 572, Wandervogel 282, Farm 533, Langbeen 277, Farm 352, Woodlands 273, Farm 338, Garcia 269, Kowise Kolk 266, Helvetia 265, Gallipoli 262, Engler 261, Farm 328, Farm 327, Gembokpan 326, Oriana Wes 325, Farm 324, Oxford 323, Mullershooop 322, Eureka 321, Hartmans Aue 320, Toekoms 319, thence generally in an easterly direction along the boundary of the magisterial districts of Gobabis and Gibeon up to the northeastern beacon of the farm Oorwinning 555, thence southwards along the South West Africa/Bechuanaland boundary up to the point of beginning.
- (vi) That portion of Rehoboth district bounded as follows: From the southern-most beacon of the farm Strate 132 along the boundaries of the following farms so as to include them in this area: the said Strate 132, Kempton 128, Keib 124, Tsaurob 106, Derm-West 109, Liineburg 112, Manhattan 81, Rem. of Limerick 80, Rietdam 409, Newlands 78, Cowdray 195, Avro 194, Lekkerwater 143, Einop 406, to its southernmost beacon of the eastern boundary of Railway Reserve 410; thence in a straight line along the prolongation of the southern boundary of the said Eirop 406, in a southwesterly direction to a point where it intersects the western boundary of the said Railway Reserve 410; thence northwards along the said western boundary of the easternmost beacon of Kunieib 387; thence along the boundaries of the following farms so as to include them in this area - the said Kunieib 387, Benoud 386, Alwynkoppies 377, Kojeka 376, Nakaeis 373, Groendraai 367, Karanas 457, Karanas Wes 456, Dikdorn 455, Khos 168, Klein Angus 495, Kobas 496, Gannavlake 497, Slangkolk 502, Spitzkop Suidwes 500, Bullsport 172, Blässkranz 7, Zais 6, Abbabis 3, Solitaire 412, Koreib 1, Farm 399 to the southernmost beacon thereof on the Rehoboth-Walvis Bay magisterial district boundary; thence generally northwards, eastwards and southwards along the boundary of the Rehoboth magisterial district to the point of beginning.

The said Hoais 842, Didau 453, Portion 1 of Geluk 466, thence in the magisterial district of Grootfontein Haijas 53, Gelnhausen 443, thence in the magisterial district of Tsumeb, Thüringen 470, Lichtenberg 473, thence in the magisterial district of Grootfontein, Eilenriede 548, Sargeberg 585, Remainder of Gaub Pad 759, Frieden 736, Ombanje 787, Maieberg 790, Keilberg 743, Gauss 46, Sommerau 757, Asis Ost 526, Blumental 527, Rendezvous 528, Remainder, Portion 2 (Guchab West) and Portion 1 of Block VI 596, Portion 3 of Cons. Rietfontein 44, Oes 160, Remainder of Gunuchas 162, Portion 2 (Linden) of Obelisk 164, Omambonde Tal 166, Waagstuk 985, Hirschgrund 986, Grenswag 981, Quo Vadis 980, Farm 973, Biesiepan 971, Farm 968, Suurverdien 964, Farm 963, Portion 2 (Hoffmanstal), Portion 3, Portion 4 (Severin) and Remainder of Warlencourt 99, Oros 98, Hermain 96, Marrieres 94, Okaputa 334, Railway Reserve between Okaputa 334 and Okaputa-Sud-West 567, Portion 1 of Okaputa-Siid-West 567, Klein Okaputa 381, Nassau 91, Vlakpan 85, Ahrensburg Siid 86, Naidaus Slid 382, Remainder and Portion 1 of Naidaus 78, Westland 330, Valhal 331, Anzio 389, Leyte 396, Uib 398, Nuims 415, Victory 416, Hestria 417, Nooitgedag 418, Olifantslaagte 433, Vrede 435, Lynplaas 436, thence in the magisterial district of Tsumeb, Mara 840, Alpha 841 and the aforementioned Hoais 842 to the point first named.
