

**NEW BRUNSWICK
REGULATION 84-1**

under the

**FISH AND WILDLIFE ACT
(O.C. 84-8)**

Under section 114.1 of the *Fish and Wildlife Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following Regulation:

2004-87

1 This Regulation may be cited as the *Species Identification Regulation - Fish and Wildlife Act*.

2004-87

2 In this Regulation

"Act" means the *Fish and Wildlife Act*;

"qualified technician" means a qualified technician appointed by the Minister under paragraph 114(c) of the Act.

2004-87

3 The procedure to be used by a qualified technician in order to determine the identity by species of any meat, tissue or body fluid shall be

(a) the Ouchterlony Precipitin Test, or

(b) the Isoelectric Focusing Test.
