1. This Order may be cited as the *Salmon Angling and Tag Use Order* .

**Tags - class 2 rivers**

2. Salmon retained by angling on rivers with a yearly quota of 2 salmon (Class 2) under section 13.1 and Schedule I of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Fishery Regulations* (Canada) shall be tagged with red tags only.

### **Tags - class 4 rivers**

3. Salmon retained by angling on rivers with a yearly quota of 4 salmon (Class 4) under section 13.1 and Schedule I of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Fishery Regulations* (Canada) shall be tagged with red or green tags only.

### **Tags - class 6 rivers**

4. (1) Salmon retained by angling on rivers with a yearly quota of 6 salmon (Class 6) under section 13.1 and Schedule I of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Fishery Regulations* (Canada) shall be tagged with red, green or blue tags.

(2) A blue tag referred to in subsection (1) may be affixed to a salmon from the first day of August to the end of the period when salmon angling and retention are permitted.

(3) A red or green tag referred to in subsection (1) may be affixed to a salmon during the period when salmon angling and retention are permitted.

(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3), a red or green tag may not be affixed to a salmon retained on the Gander River from September 8 to the end of the period when salmon angling and retention are permitted on that river.

### **Tags - unclassified rivers in Labrador**

5. Salmon retained by angling on rivers that are unclassified in Zone 1 and 2 (Labrador) with a yearly quota of 4 salmon under section 13.1 and Schedule I of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Fishery Regulations* (Canada) shall be tagged with red or green tags only.

### **Tags - non-scheduled rivers**

7. Salmon retained by angling on a river or other inland waters with a yearly quota of 2 salmon (Class 2) under section 13.1 of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Fishery Regulations* (Canada) that is not listed in Schedule I of those regulations shall be tagged with red tags only.

immediately cut out and remove the month and day of capture on the tag.
