

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred by The Logging Camps Act, 1960, the Act No. 21 of 1960, and of all other powers enabling him on this behalf, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as The Licencing of Logging Camps Regulations, 1961.
2. Subject to these regulations the Minister may, upon receipt of the fee prescribed by regulation 7, issue to any person a logging camp licence authorizing that person to operate a logging camp or a small logging camp.
3. A logging camp licence shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the logging camp authorized to be operated by the licence.
4. Applications for a logging camp licence shall be made in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto.
5. The application shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed in regulation 7.
6. No person shall operate a logging camp or small logging camp unless there is a valid logging camp licence in existence in respect of that camp.
7. The fee for a logging camp licence shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) in respect of a permanent logging camp and two dollars (\$2.00) in respect of logging camps other than permanent logging camps.
8. A logging camp licence, unless sooner revoked, shall expire on the thirty-first day of March next after issue.

9. No person shall apply for a logging camp licence unless the camp for which such application is being made conforms and is maintained in accordance with The Logging Camps Act, 1960, the Act No. 21 of 1960, as amended, and the regulations made thereunder.

10. If, in the opinion of the Minister or his authorized representative, a logging camp or a small logging camp is being operated contrary to The Logging Camps Act, 1960, the Act No. 21 of 1960, as amended, and the regulations made thereunder, the Minister or his authorized representative may revoke or suspend the logging camp licence issued in respect of any such camp.

11. When a logging camp licence has been suspended the officer making such a suspension shall inform the operator of the camp concerned.

(a) why the licence is being suspended, and

(b) of the duration of this suspension.

12. No person shall apply for a logging camp licence in respect of any camp for which a logging camp licence has been revoked until after the thirty-first day of March next after revocation.
