

## **CONSOLIDATED NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR REGULATION 777/96**

*Forest Management Districts Proclamation*  
under the  
*Forestry Act*  
(O.C. 96-179)

Under the authority of section 7 of the *Forestry Act* and the *Subordinate Legislation Revision and Consolidation Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council proclaims the areas described in the Schedule to be forest management districts.

**The Forest Management Areas Proclamation, 1979, Newfoundland Regulation 72/79, the Forest Management Areas Proclamation (No. 2), 1979, Newfoundland Regulation 127/79, and the Proclamation re Forest Management Districts, Newfoundland Regulation 191/92, are repealed.**

### **Schedule**

#### **Forest Management District 1**

##### **Avalon**

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point at the mouth of the Come-by-Chance River;

Then following the Come-by-Chance River in a generally northerly direction to its intersection with the Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro transmission line;

Then following the transmission line in an easterly direction across the Trans Canada, Route 1, continuing for approximately 2,529.8 metres more or less until it intersects another transmission line running in a north-south direction;

Then following this second transmission line in a generally southerly direction for 121.9 metres more or less to a point where it intersects a stream;

Then following the stream in a generally northeasterly direction to the mouth of the stream which empties into the salt waters of Bull Arm in Trinity Bay;

Then following the coastline in a generally southeasterly direction to the most southerly point in Dildo Arm;

Then following the coastline in a generally northeasterly direction to a point known as Grates Point;

Then following the coastline in a generally southerly direction to the most southerly point in South Arm in Holyrood Bay;

Then following the coastline in a generally northeasterly direction to a point known as Cape St. Francis;

Then following the coastline in a generally southerly direction to a point known as Mistaken Point;

Then following the coastline in a generally westerly and northerly and southerly direction to a point known as Cape Pine;

Then following the coastline in a generally northerly direction to the most northerly point of Colinet Harbour;

Then following the coastline in a generally southerly direction to a point known as Cape St. Mary's;

Then following the coastline in a generally northerly direction to the point of commencement and including all offshore islands except those in Placentia Bay.

## Forest Management District 2

### Clarenville

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point at the mouth of the Come-by-Chance River then following the Come-by-Chance River in a generally northerly direction to its intersection with the Newfoundland and Labrador hydro transmission line;

Then following the transmission line in an easterly direction across the Trans Canada, Route 1, continuing for approximately 2,529.8 metres more or less until it intersects another transmission line running in a north-south direction;

Then following this second transmission line in a generally southerly direction for 121.9 metres more or less to a point where it intersects a stream;

Then following the stream in a generally northeasterly direction to the mouth of the stream which empties into the salt waters of Bull Arm in Trinity Bay;

Then following the north side of Trinity Bay in a generally northeasterly direction to Cape Bonavista including the island known as Random Island;

Then proceeding in a generally westerly direction along the shoreline of the south side of Bonavista Bay through Chandlers Reach and Clode Sound to that point where the eastern boundary of the Terra Nova National Park intersects with the shoreline;

Then in a generally northwesterly direction along the boundary to a point where it intersects with the southeast corner of the former Reid Lot 96, Grant No. 79R, Vol. 71, Folio 73;

Then in a generally westerly direction to the southern boundary of the Reid Lot 96, 11.3 kilometres more or less;

Then in a generally southwesterly direction a distance of 6.4 kilometres more or less;

Then in a generally southerly direction a distance of 13.7 kilometres more or less;

Then in a generally southwesterly direction a distance of 11.3 kilometres more or less to intersect with the headwaters of that river commonly called Pipers Hole River;

Then following the Easterly bank of the river to that point where it empties into the head of Placentia Bay near the point of land commonly called Come-by-Chance Point;

Then along the shoreline of the Northern end of Placentia Bay to the point of commencement.

Forest Management District 3

Burin Peninsula

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at Long Harbour Point;

Then proceeding north along the west side of Long Harbour;

Then continuing inland following the Long Harbour River to the headwaters of a body of water known as Eastern Meelpaeg;

Then along the west side of the body of water to the southern boundary of a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Ltd., originally licensed to Terra Nova Sulphite Co. Limited and registered in Vol. 7, Folio 5;

Then following the boundary of the block in a generally northeasterly direction to intersect with the headwaters of that river commonly called Pipers Hole River;

Then following the western boundary of Management District 2 to that point where it empties into Placentia Bay near the point of land commonly called Come-by-Chance Point;

Then continuing in a generally southerly direction to include the large islands known as Merasheen Island, Long Island, and Red Island and other smaller islands offshore;

Then in a generally southwesterly direction along the west side of Placentia Bay to the community known as Point May on the southern tip of the Burin Peninsula;

Then in a generally northeasterly direction along the eastern shore of Fortune Bay to the community known as Terrenceville;

Then continuing in a westerly direction along the northern shore of Fortune Bay to the point of commencement.

Forest Management District 4

Terra Nova

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at the northeast corner of former Reid Lot 245, Vol. 71, Folio 144;

Then south until it meets land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Limited, Vol. 7, Folio 5;

Then east along the boundary until it meets the southwest corner of former Reid Lot 90, Vol. 71, Folio 68;

Then north;

Then east;

Then south along the boundary of the lot 90 to its southeast corner;

Then east following the boundary of a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 7, Folio 5;

Then generally south following the eastern boundary of the block of land to a point where it meets the northeast corner of former Reid Lot 96, Vol. 71, Folio 73;

Then south till it intersects with the boundary of Terra Nova National Park;

Then west along the southern boundary of lot 96 to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol 7, Folio 5;

Then following the boundary of the block of land generally south;

Then generally west;

Then generally northeast to a point east of Dead Wolf Pond;

Then north;

Then east to the northwest corner of former Reid Lot 245;

Then east to point of commencement.

#### Forest Management District 5

##### Bonavista North

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point approximately 5.6 kilometres south of Clarks Head where Gander River enters Notre Dame Bay;

Then in a generally southwesterly direction along the west bank of the river to a point where the river enters Gander Lake;

Then in a generally easterly direction along Gander Lake to a point where the east boundary of Bowater R.G.R. Lot 4, Vol. 61, Folio 4, meets the southern shore of Gander Lake;

Then south along former R.G.R. Lot 4 and former Reid Lot 85, Vol. 71, Folio 65, to its southeast corner;

Then west along the lot to a point where it meets land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd., Vol. 7, Folio 40;

Then south and then west along the parcel of land to a point where it meets Second Burnt Pond;

Then south along another parcel of land licensed to Bowater, Vol. 5, Folio 57, to a point where it meets the northern boundary of Management District 4;

Then east along the northern boundary of Management District 4;

Then following the eastern boundary of Management District 4 to a point where the southeast corner of former Reid Lot 96, Vol. 71, Folio 73, intersects with the boundary of Terra Nova National Park;

Then following the boundary of the park in a generally northeasterly direction to a point where it enters North Broad Cove, Newman Sound;

Then following the coastline in a generally northerly direction to a point of commencement including Fogo Island and all other offshore islands.

## Forest Management District 6

### Glenwood

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point on the east side of Bowater R.G.R. Lot 4, Vol. 61, Folio 4, where the boundary of the lot meets the southside of Gander Lake;

Then south following the boundary of Management District 5 to a point where it meets the northern boundary of Management District 4;

Then west along the northern boundary of Management District 4 to a point north of Great Gull Lake where the boundary intersects with a block of land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 15, and land owned by the Crown;

Then following the boundary of the block south;

Then west;

Then north;

Then west;

Then south;

Then west;

Then north to a point where it meets a brook flowing into Sitdown Pond;

Then west along the brook to Sitdown Pond;

Then south along the east side of Sitdown Pond to a point where it meets a brook flowing into North Salmon River;

Then following the brook generally south to a point where it meets North Salmon River;

Then generally northwest following the river to the eastern shore of Great Burnt Lake;

Then generally northwest along the eastern and northern shores of Great Burnt Lake to where it meets a brook flowing between Great Burnt Lake and Crooked Lake;

Then along the brook and the eastern shore of Crooked Lake to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 201;

Then northeast and northwest along the boundary of the block of land to where it meets a parcel of land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land chartered to A.N.D. Co. Ltd. under special Act, commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905;

Then along the boundary of the chartered land to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot No. 5;

Then following the boundary of the block of land until it meets another block of land licensed to Price, Vol. 5, Folio 11;

Then following the boundary of the block of land to where it meets that block;

Then north following the boundary of the block to the southern boundary of Price Reid Lot 65, Vol. 71, Folio 47;

Then east;

Then north along the boundary of Lot 65 until it intersects with land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd, special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot 4;

Then east to Bowater Reid Lot 67, Vol. 71, Folio 49;

Then north;

Then northeast along the railway track to the southwest corner of Bowater Reid Lot 68, Vol. 71, Folio 50;

Then south to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot No. 2;

Then northeast along the boundary of the lot to where it intersects the western boundary of Bowater Reid Lot 69, Vol. 71, Folio 51;

Then north along the boundary of the lot to where it intersects with the railway line;

Then generally in a southeasterly direction along the railway line to a point where it meets the western boundary of a block of land owned by Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Grant 5448;

Then north;

Then east along the boundary of the lot to where it intersects with the boundary of Management District 5;

Then south;

Then east along the southern boundary of Management District 5 to point of commencement.

#### Bay d'Espoir

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at Long Harbour Point in Fortune Bay;

Then following the western boundary of Management District 3 to the southern boundary of a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 7, Folio 5;

Then following the boundary of the block in a generally northwesterly direction to a point where it intersects a block of land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 15, and the boundary of Management District 6;

Then generally west along the boundary to a point on Crooked Lake where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 201;

Then following the boundary of the block of land until it meets a block of land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land chartered to A.N.D. Ltd. under special Act commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905;

Then following the boundary of the said block of land in a southwesterly direction until it intersects with a river south of Blizzard Pond;

Then following the river in a generally southwesterly direction to the northern shore of Granite Lake Reservoir;

Then along the east side of Granite Lake to a point where it meets the canal that flows into Meelpaeg Lake;

Then south along the shore of Meelpaeg Lake to where it meets waters of the Grey River;

Then south along the waters of the Grey River to a point of land known as Grey River Point;

Then east along the shores of Hermitage Bay to include Bois Island and other small offshore islands;

Then south to include the large islands known as Long Island and Brunnet Island and other small offshore islands;

Then northeast along the western and northern shores of Fortune Bay to include the large island known as Chapel Island and other small offshore islands to point of commencement.

##### Bay of Exploits

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point approximately 5.6 kilometres south of Clarks Head where Gander River enters Notre Dame Bay;

Then generally in a southwesterly direction following the western boundary of Management District 5 to a point where it meets the northeast corner of a block of land owned by Price Nfld. Pulp and Paper Ltd., Grant No. 5448, and the boundary of Management District 6;

Then generally west along the boundary of Management District 6 to a point where it intersects with a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot 4;

Then southwest along a boundary of the lot to a point where it intersects the eastern boundary of Price Reid Lot 65, Vol. 71, Folio 47;

Then following the boundary of the lot north;

Then southwest;

Then south approximately 4 kilometres to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot No. 5;

Then following the boundary of lot 5 in a generally northwesterly direction to a point where it intersects with a block of private land owned by Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Grant No. 311;

Then northwest along the boundary of the grant approximately 1.9 kilometres to the bank of the Exploits River;

Then following the bank of the Exploits River southwest to the Sir Robert Bond Bridge;

Then crossing the bridge to the north bank of the river;

Then northeast to a point where it intersects with a block of private land owned by Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Grant 311;

Then north along the boundary of a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 2, Folio 109;

Then generally southwest to another block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Grant No. 111 to Nfld. Pine and Pulp Co. Ltd.;

Then generally northeast along the boundary of the block of land and another block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 8, to a point where it meets the southwest corner of Price Reid Lot 237, Vol. 71, Folio 136;

Then along the boundary of the lot east;

Then north;

Then generally northwest to a point where it intersects with a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 8; then generally northwest along the boundary of the block of land to a point where it intersects with Seal Bay Brook;

Then following the brook in a generally northerly direction to where it enters Seal Bay in Notre Dame Bay;

Then generally north to the eastern extremity of League Rock in Notre Dame Bay;

Then generally northeast to the Northern extremity of Gull Island north of Twillingate Island;

Then east to the northern extremity of Bacalhao Island in Notre Dame Bay;

Then generally southeast to the northern extremity of Change Island;

Then to the eastern extremity of Change Island;

Then southeast to a point midway between Change Islands and Fogo Island;

Then generally south to the point of commencement.

Then northwest;



Then southwest along the boundary of the block of land to where it intersects with another block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., Vol. 2, Folio 107;

Then west along the boundary of the block of land to where it meets another block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 43, Lot 2;

Then southwest to the northeast corner of Bowater Reid Lot 50, Vol. 71, Folio 42;

Then south along the boundary of the lot to the railway track and land owned by the Crown;

Then generally southwest along the boundary of the Crown land to a point where it meets land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land chartered to A.N. D. Co. Ltd. under special Act commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905;

Then generally northwest along the chartered land to a point where it meets land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Limited, Bowater Licensed Lot 60, Vol. 5, Folio 49;

Then following the boundary of the lot and land chartered to Price generally north;

Then generally southwest;

Then generally west and north to a point where it meets land owned by the Crown;

Then north along the boundary of Bowater Licensed Lot 60, Vol. 5, Folio 49, to where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 403;

Then continuing north along the boundary to where it meets the southeast corner of a block of land licensed to Bowater, Bowater Licensed Lot 29, Vol. 5, Folio 92, Lot 5;

Then north to its northeast corner;

Then west along the boundary of the lot to where it meets the northeast corner of Bowater Reid Lot 219, Vol. 71, Folio 119;

Then west following the boundary of the lot to where it meets the northeast corner of Birchy Lake;

Then following the north shore of Birchy Lake and Birchy Narrows to the eastern shoreline of Sandy Lake;

Then in a general northwesterly direction following the eastern shoreline of Sandy Lake to a point where the Hampden Road meets the Trans Canada Highway;

Then generally north following the Hampden Road, Route 420, to the town of Hampden excluding the Crown land on the east side of the Hampden Road;

Then generally northeast along the eastern shore of White Bay to Partridge Point;

Then generally east to include the Horse Islands;

Then generally southeast to Cape St. John;

Then generally south to the eastern extremity of League Rock Island;

Then generally south following the western boundary of Management District 8 to point of commencement.

## New Bay

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point on the north side of the Exploits River where the Sir Robert Bond Bridge crosses the river;

Then following western boundary of Management District 8 to a point where it meets Seal Bay Brook and the boundary of Management District 9;

Then generally west and southwest along the boundary of Management District 9 to the southeast corner of Bowater Reid Lot 50, Vol. 71, Folio 42, and the railway track;

Then east along the railway track to the north bank of Exploits River;

The following the river east to point of commencement.

### Grand Falls

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point on the north side of the Exploits River where the Sir Robert Bond Bridge crosses the river;

Then generally east along the southern boundary of Management District 8 to a point where it meets a block of land licensed to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., special grant, Vol. 2, Folio 139, Lot 4, and the western boundary of Management District 6;

Then following the boundary of Management District 6 generally southwest to a point east of the southeast corner of Price Reid Lot 235, Vol. 71, Folio 135;

Then west to the southeast corner of Reid Lot 235;

Then north;

Then west along boundary of the lot to where it meets Noel Paul's Brook;

Then generally northwest along Noel Paul's Brook to where it enters the Exploits River;

Then northeast along Exploits River to the town of Badger where it meets the boundary of Management District 10;

Then east along the southern boundary of Management District 10 and Exploits River to point of commencement.

## Forest Management District 12

### Millertown

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point east of the town of Badger where the boundaries of Management Districts 10 and 11 intersect;

Then generally southwest along the Exploits River, Noel Paul's Brook and the western boundary of Management District 11 to a point where it intersects the boundary of Management District 6 east of Price Reid Lot 235, Vol. 71, Folio 135;

Then generally southwest following the boundary of Management District 6 to a point where it meets the boundary of Management District 7 at Crooked Lake;

Then generally southeast along the boundary of Management District 7 to a point south of Blizzard Pond where it meets a river flowing into Granite Lake;

Then northwest along the boundary of land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land chartered to A.N.D. Co. Ltd. by a special Act commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905, to a point approximately 1.6 kilometres west of Blizzard Pond where it intersects with a small pond;

Then generally northeast following a system of small ponds and brooks to the east side of Hospital Pond where it meets a river flowing between Hospital Pond and Wilding Lake;

Then following the river to the south side of Wilding Lake;

Then along the west side of Wilding Lake;

Then following the river that flows between Wilding Lake and Rogerson Lake to a point approximately 5.3 kilometres east of the southeast corner of Price Reid Lot 229, Lot 71, Folio 129;

Then west to the southeast corner of the lot;

Then following the southern boundary of the lot to the west side of Rodeross Lake;

Then following the west side of Rodeross Lake southwest and the brook running out of the lake until it meets Victoria River;

Then north along Victoria River to the southern boundary of Price Reid Lot 229;

Then west along the boundary of the lot to its southwest corner;

Then north along the western boundary of the lot and the east boundary of Price Reid Lot 228, Vol. 71, Folio 128, to the northeast corner of Price Reid Lot 228;

Then west along the northern boundary of the lot to a point where it meets a brook flowing between Star Lake and Red Indian Lake;

Then northwest along the brook to Star Lake;

Then along the north shore of Star Lake until it meets a brook in the northwest corner of the lake;

Then west along the brook approximately 4.8 kilometres to its southwest branch;

Then west along the branch until it meets the western boundary of land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land originally chartered to A.N.D. Co. Ltd. by special Act commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905;

Then north, northeast and east along the boundary of the chartered land to a point where it meets the boundary of Management District 9 northeast of Patricks Pond;

Then generally south;

Then generally east along the southern boundaries of Management Districts 9 and 10 to the point of commencement.

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at a point approximately 1.6 kilometres west of Blizzard Pond where the boundary of Management District 12 and land chartered to Price (Nfld.) Pulp and Paper Ltd., land originally chartered to A.N.D. Co. Ltd. by a special Act commonly called the *Pulp and Paper Act*, 1905 intersect;

Then southwest;

Then northwest;

Then northeast along the boundary of the chartered land to a point where it meets the southern boundary of Management District 12;

Then generally southeast along the boundary to point of commencement.

All the Crown land within the following area:

Commencing at Grey River Point east of Ramea Island;

Then southwest;

Then northwest;

Then northeast along the boundary of Management District 13 to where it intersects the boundary of Management District 12;

Then north along the boundary of Management District 12 to a point where it intersects Bowater Reid Lot 222, Vol. 71, Folio 122;

Then west to a point where the boundary of the Reid Lot intersects with the eastern boundary of a block of land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 97;

Then southwest along the boundary of the lot to where it intersects with the eastern boundary of Bowater Reid Lot 225, Vol. 71, Folio 125;

Then south;

Then west along the boundary of the said lot to a point where it intersects with the northern shore of Little Grand Lake;

Then generally northwest along the shore of Little Grand Lake to Lewaseechjeech Brook;

Then following the brook generally northwest to a point where the brook enters Grand Lake;

Then generally west along the south shore of Grand Lake to where the waters of a brook commonly called Grand Lake Brook enters into Grand Lake;

Then following the brook generally northwest to a point where the brook meets the Tans Canada Highway;

Then continuing generally southwest along the highway to a point where it interest with the boundary of Bowater Licensed Lot 3, Vol. 5, Folio 98;

Then south;

Then west along the boundary of the lot until it meets the boundary of Bowater Reid Lot 23, Vol. 71, Folio 16;

Then west;

Then north;

Then east along the boundary of the lot until it meets the boundary of a block of land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd., Vol. 5, Folio 98;

Then north;

Then east along the boundary of the block of land to where it meets the southwest corner of Bowater Reid Lot 25, Vol. 71, Folio 18;

Then north along the boundary of the lot to where it meets the boundary of a block of land licensed to Bowater Nfld. Ltd, Vol. 5, Folio 98;

Then north;

Then east along the boundary of the block of land to where it meets the southwest corner of Bowater Reid Lot 27, Vol. 71, Folio 21;

Then north along the boundary of the lot to its northwest corner;

Then due west to the eastern boundary of Reid Lot 202, Vol. 71, Folio 104;

Then south;

Then west along the boundary of the lot to its southwest corner;

Then due west to a point on the coast 0.8 kilometres north of Lewis Brook;

Then generally south and east along the coast including all offshore islands to point of commencement.

Forest Management District 15

Corner Brook

All the Crown land within the following area:
