Short title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Small Scale Operations Regulations*.

Definitions

2. In this Act,

(a) "Act" means the *Mining Act*; and

(a) "guidelines" means the guidelines made by the minister under the Act and regulations.

Criteria prescribed

3. The minister may, upon application, designate an operation as a small scale operation based on the minister's consideration of

- (a) the nature of the materials mined or milled;
- (b) the location of operation with respect to surface or underground mining;
- (c) whether the operation requires a tailings impoundment area;
- (d) the total volume or tonnage produced by the operation;
- (e) the size of the area the operation affects; and
- (f) those other particulars that may be described by the minister in the guidelines to the Act.
